**Paris, France** – From June 10 through August 16, 2008 the City of Paris will pay special tribute to Princess Grace of Monaco by welcoming *The Grace Kelly Years: Princess of Monaco* exhibition which was so spectacularly staged at the Grimaldi Forum Monaco in the summer of 2007.

The exhibition, which will be free and open to the public at the Hôtel de Ville - the City Hall in Paris - will feature clothing, jewelry, photographs, letters, film clips, home video and other unique items, spanning the extraordinary life of Grace Kelly, from Hollywood star and style icon to Princess of Monaco, wife, mother and humanitarian.

Curated by renowned French media personality Frédéric Mitterrand, the tribute exhibition highlights the work of some of the world's most acclaimed photographers - Conant, Beaton, Penn, and will feature correspondence between Hollywood friends and international personalities including Jacqueline Kennedy, Alfred Hitchcock, Maria Callas and Cary Grant. Personal belongings on display will include outfits from her wardrobe, jewelry and other accessories such as the Hermès bag which bears her name.

Her cinematic career as well as her life as Princess of Monaco as wife to Prince Rainier and mother to Princess Caroline, Prince Albert and Princess Stephanie will also be represented via film clips, letters and personal memorabilia.
